

## **Intellector Announces Plans to Move Corporate Headquarters to Columbus**

*Global Human Capital Management Firm Expects to Bring 25-50 New Jobs to Central Ohio*

**Columbus, Ohio (June 6, 2008)**- Intellector, a global human capital management firm helping corporations and government agencies in more than 32 countries attract, recruit, develop and retain top talent, announced today that it will relocate its corporate headquarters to Columbus. The move will be complete by the end of 2008. Early plans are to bring 25 to 50 senior level jobs to Central Ohio over the next 18 months.

Intellector, currently headquartered in Jacksonville, Florida, has 25 employees and a network of more than 100 consultants based in the United States, Europe and Asia. The company established an office in the central Ohio market in 2007 to assist with the transition process and to begin to establish a local presence. The office is located at 545 Metro Place South in Dublin.

Intellector's move to Columbus is part of the company's aggressive 18-month growth plan that will create 25 to 50 new senior level positions in Central Ohio to support the global recruitment, talent retention and management needs of clients such as Boeing and Royal Dutch Shell. Intellector specializes in the search and selection of talent that require critical skills sets that help move an organization forward – whether its 300 engineers or a hard to fill position that requires unique expertise.

“We believe that Columbus is a strong, vibrant market with an exceptional workforce,” said John Hamilton, President and CEO of Intellector. Columbus' strong family values and sense of community are parallel to those of Intellector's. We believe this move will offer the quality of life necessary for Intellector to attract top talent. This is the ideal location to take our company to the next level.”

The move to Columbus comes on the heels of the company's 2007 acquisition of ADI Solutions, which was located in Washington, DC, and the January acquisition of Phoenix, AZ based GRL Search Solutions. A search and selection firm, GRL has played a role in putting over 25,000 people to work since 2001. Through these acquisitions, Intellector will play a complete or partial role in putting between 35,000 to 45,000 people to work per year globally. This number is expected to double over the next three years based upon current contracts and projected new client growth, according to Hamilton.

Intellectcor places a strong emphasis on corporate social responsibility, donating a large percentage of its annual revenue to local, national and international organizations, charities and ministries. A recent example of Intellectcor's commitment is the development of a scholarship fund that will help to educate 1,500 students in Cameroon, Africa. Intellectcor hopes to extend that number by an additional 1,500 in the next 18 months.

"Companies have a responsibility to be good stewards of what we have been given," Hamilton said. "Most people think our tag line, 'Bringing people together for a greater cause,' deals with the recruitment aspect of our business. It actually conveys the social responsibility that comes from our success in business."
